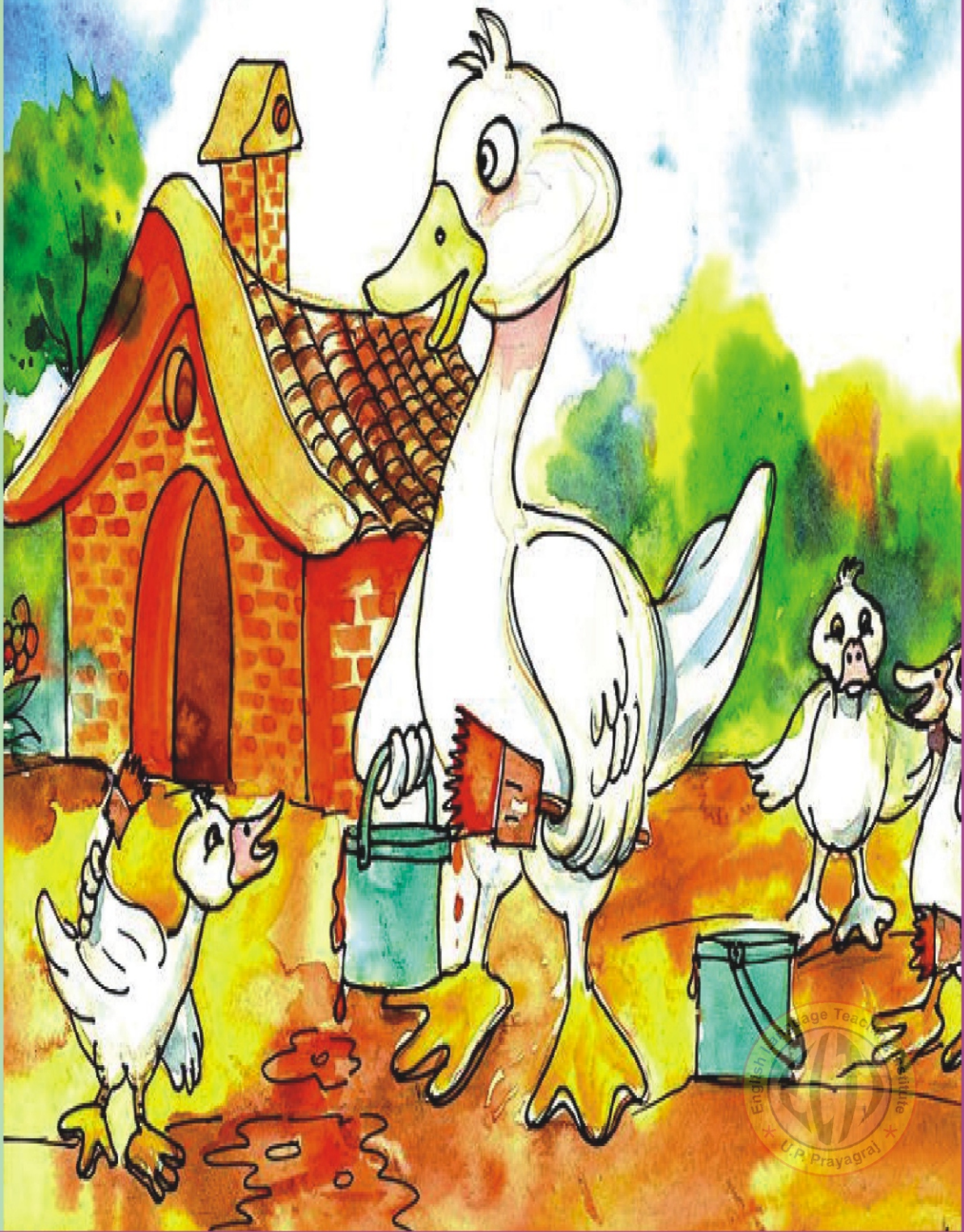
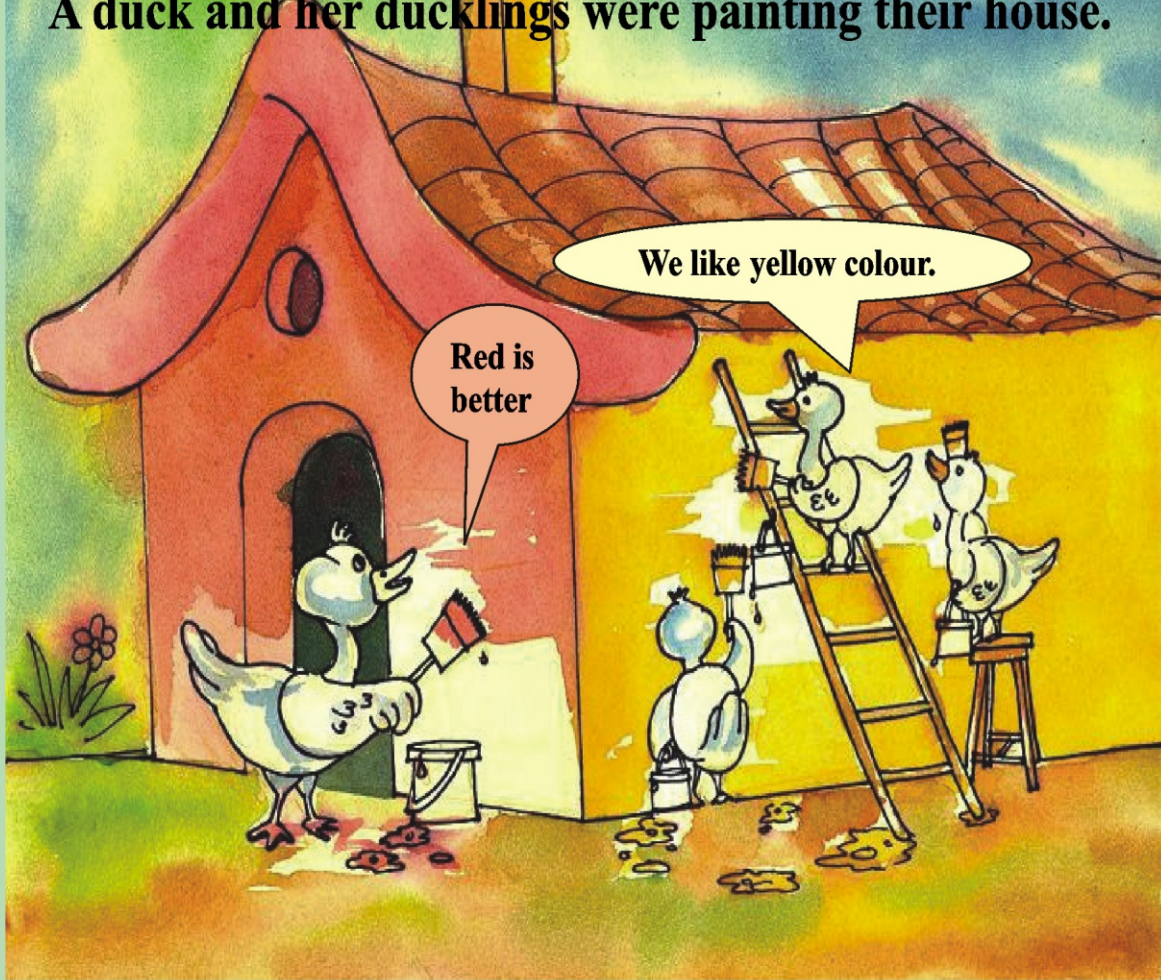


# DUCK'S HOUSE

**We like yellow colour.**

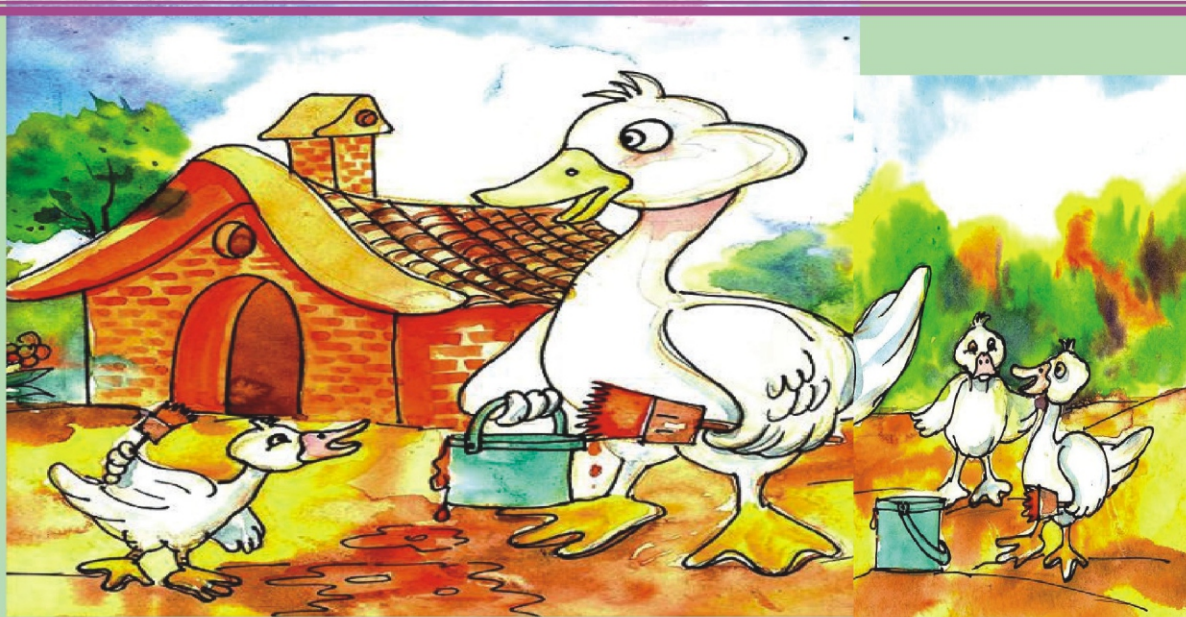
**Red is better**

are you?

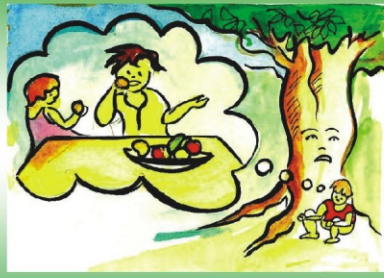
I am not

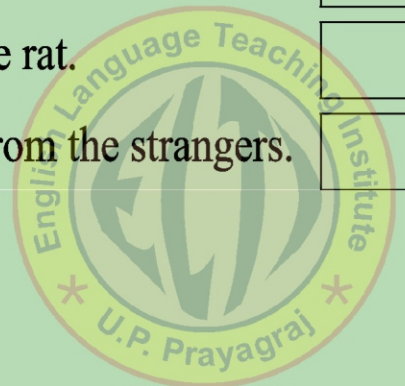

# A BIG CARROT

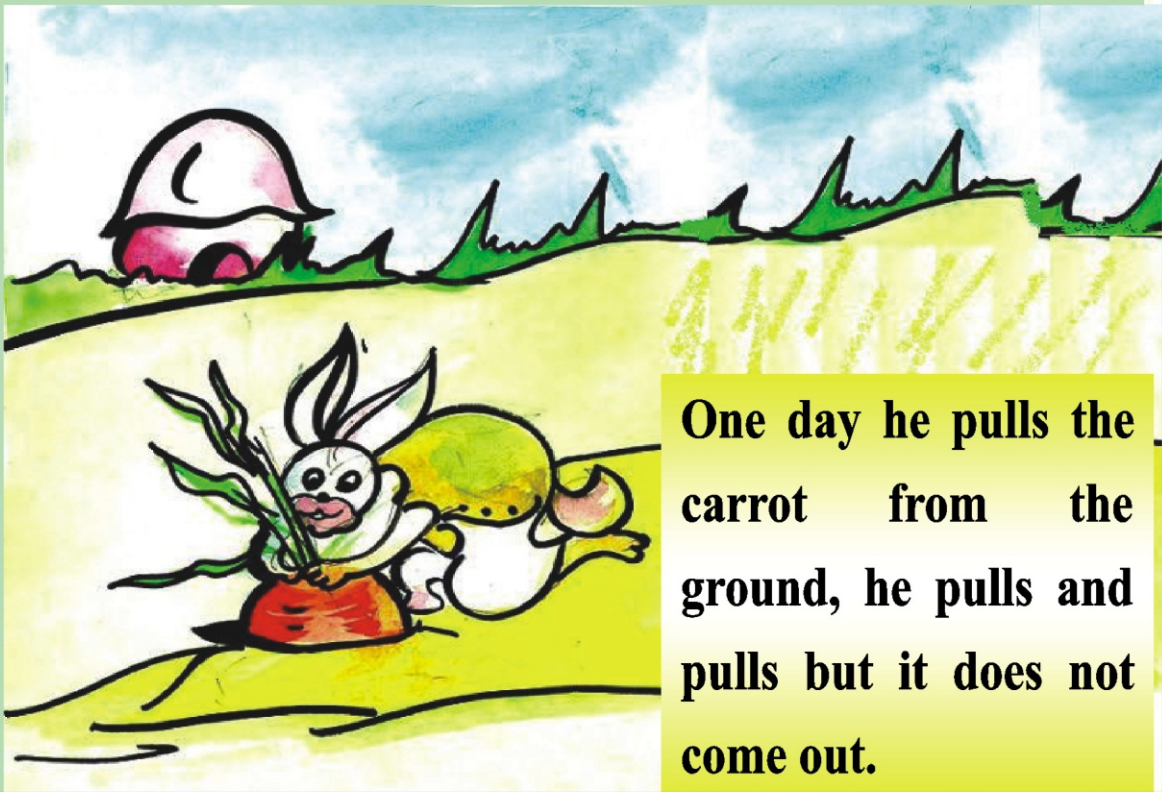


**Chikoo rabbit loves carrots.**





**So he plants a carrot in his garden. He waters it daily and soon the plant becomes big.**

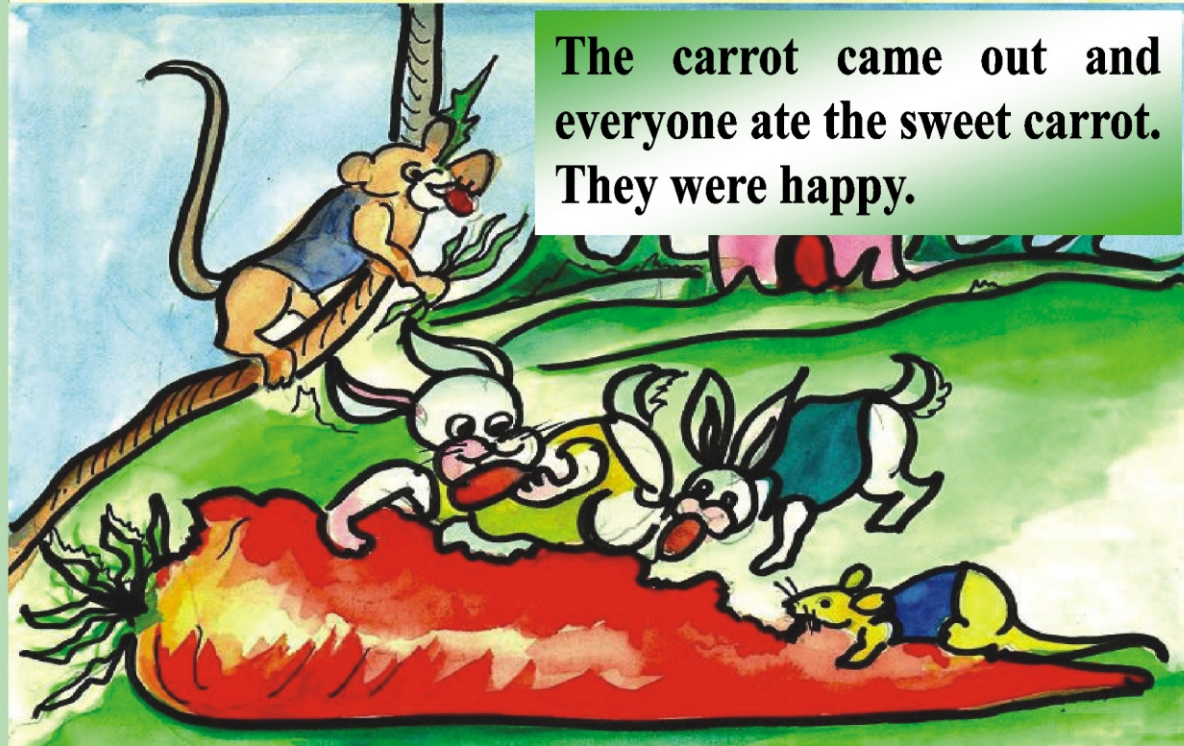


**One day he pulls the carrot from the ground, he pulls and pulls but it does not come out.**




**Ramu lived in a village.

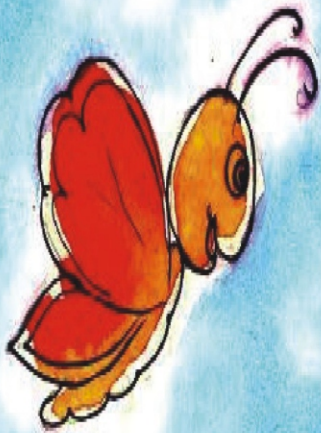
